

Book Report Instructions

A book report is assigned for each of the following months: Sep., Nov., Jan., and Apr. The books will be checked out with my approval, on the first Monday of each book report month, and the report will be due the last day of the same month unless the last day of the month is on a weekend, then the report will be due the Friday before. The book report must include the following information:

1. Who were the main characters?
2. Where did the story take place?
3. A summary of the story that includes the overall problem and solution
4. Whether or not you liked the book and why or why not.
5. Would you recommend the book, to whom, and why or why not?

Except for the first report, due in September, you may choose to do a traditional 5-paragraph book report or may choose to do one of ideas on the "Book Report Ideas" sheet. September's book report **must** be a 5-paragraph essay. Remember each "report", written or project, must include some form of the above five requirements.

When doing a traditional 5-paragraph book report the paragraphs should be set up in the following way:

1st Paragraph: Include the book title, author, main characters and the setting (where and when it took place).

2nd, 3rd, and 4th Paragraphs: A summary of the story including only the important details in the order they happened. The overall problem and solution to the problem must be included in these paragraphs.

5th Paragraph: Include whether or not you liked the book and why or why not. Also include whether or not you would recommend the book to someone and why or why not.
